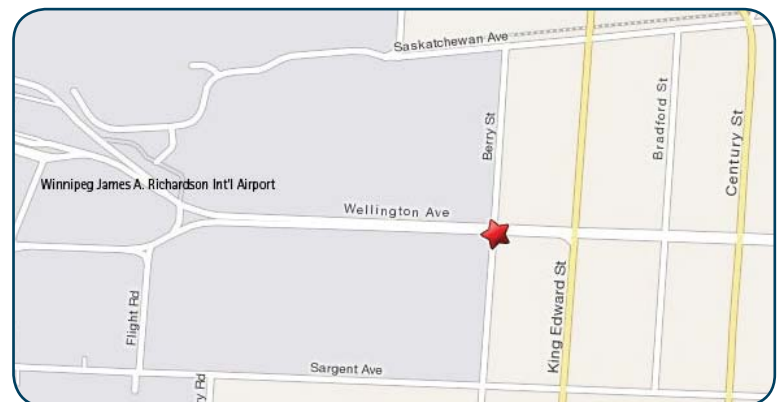
ADDRESS AND DIRECTIONS TO VICTORIA INN HOTEL
