- 1) Has your leadership team struggled with knowing which secular leadership principles are appropriate to use in Christian ministry? Or has your leadership team struggled more with following godly ways that run counter to secular ways?
- 2) It is important to discern when worldly wisdom falls too short of godly wisdom to be used with integrity in Christian ministry. Can you define the criteria for acceptability ahead of time?
- 3) If you use worldly wisdom without theological reflection, how might your ministry be hurt in terms of witness?
- 4) In what ways does your leadership team leave room for God to act and do what only he can do?
- 5) Share stories from the history of your ministry of times of great faith and trust and how God came through. Are you still living in that faith and trust today? If you don't have such stories, how can you begin to demonstrate faith and trust in God as an organization?
