- 1) To this point in your ministry, have you given much thought as to how you will finish out your leadership role? What do you want your legacy to be ten years after you've finished at the ministry? What do you want the defining characteristics of your leadership to be?
- 2) Think about the characteristics of leaders who don't finish well, and reflect on how you are doing with each:
 - a) Are you at risk of losing your learning posture? What do you do to be a lifelong learner?
 - b) Has the attractiveness of your character waned in any way? Has power gone to your head? Do you lose emotional control?
 - c) Have you stopped living by your convictions in any area? Are you a worthy representative of Jesus Christ to your staff?
 - d) Are you on track to leave behind an ultimate contribution?
 - e) Are you walking in an awareness of influence and destiny? Do you link your behaviour to its impact on other people and their ability to be all that God made them to be?
 - f) Do you have a vibrant relationship with God?
- Does the thought of ultimately finishing well inspire you to determine to do so?
- 4) Think about how you can purpose to finish your ministry well. What concrete plans can you put in place to ensure that end?
