- 1) Take a moment to reflect on who “the Other” is to you personally. Do the same to define who “the Other” might be for your ministry as a whole. Are you ready to love them like Jesus loves?
- 2) How will using love, prayer, spiritual discernment, and deep engagement as your go-to tools change the way you view “the Other”? Determine what God wants you to achieve in your relationship with them and use those tools to move toward his goal.
- 3) If your ministry doesn’t already have one, develop an intentional discipleship program that includes formation and mission elements. If not a program, at least be intentional about how you want your leadership to develop your staff as Christians. Use the resources mentioned in the blog post to help in that process.
- 4) Determine how you will measure the effectiveness of your discipleship program, and ultimately the maturity of the Christians in the program. What indicators will mark their development along the way?
- 5) Commit to being culturally aware and ready at all times to engage with those in your sphere of influence. As a leader, model faithful representation of Christ to the world.
