- 1) In your own words, write down why it is not a good idea to define yourself in terms of your leadership role.

- 3) Jesus and the Prodigal Son both received unconditional love from their fathers. How does knowing that you also receive God's unconditional love as his child affect how you think of your work? Does it change anything about how you approach your job?
- 4) How would your team dynamics change if everyone answered the question "Who am I" in alignment with Psalm 100:3? How could you help your staff members give a good, Christian answer to the question, "Who am I?"
