

- 1) Every leader has a story about how they came to have the leadership role they have. Some had specific, even dramatic, calls from the Lord. Others felt no particular call but just followed what they thought the Lord would want of them. Whatever your story is, write it out so that it is documented. You will undoubtedly find many ways to make use of it.
- 2) You will grow in Christlike leadership as you examine your own leadership in light of Christ's character. Take a few hours and reflect on how you lead and how others experience your leadership. How closely do you resemble Jesus? In what ways could your leadership become even more like Jesus's leadership?
