- 1) If you haven't already documented your call story, write it out or video yourself telling the story. Whether your call was a specific event with obvious Divine intervention or it was a gradual process where God seemed to be in the background, you have a story to tell! Be sure to include what was going on in your life at the time, what you were expecting or hoping for, and any other background facts that relate to the call. How did you discern Christ's call? What reflections do you have looking back on that time in your life?
- 2) In Revelation 2:4-5, John wrote to the church in Ephesus: "You have left your first love. Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first." Give yourself an honest self-assessment: Are you still as fervently engaged in the spiritual practices and hunger to discern God's leadership as you were when you were first called? What do you want to affirm about your spirituality today and what would you like to change about it? Create an action plan you can commit to that will keep you closely following your Great Shepherd's voice.
