Literature Review

- Broaden your thinking: Find and review the latest research that applies to your corporate mission and the program rationale.
 - Consider research from various perspectives including psychology, sociology, economics, politics, education, etc.
- Deepen your understanding: What are the goals that various groups are pursuing?
 - What values and priorities are in play by various groups?
 - Review all the research and check for conflicts and choices.
 - List the areas of agreement or consensus.
 - Identify where there are conflicts.
 - Specify the precise points of divergence or conflict and research these further
 - List explicit and implicit choices that you detect in the literature.
- Compare the literature review results to your program design.
 - What changes does the literature review suggest you should make to your program?
 - Aside from the program under evaluation, does the literature review suggest anything else that your ministry should start or stop doing or change?
