- 1) Review your updated understanding of your call. Ask yourself these questions:
  - a) Could I fulfill my new understanding of my call in my current ministry role?
  - b) Could I fulfill it in a different role in my current ministry?
  - c) Has God released me to move to a different ministry or to leave ministry?
  - d) Who are the people who know me and can bear witness about what they perceive to be the rightness what I've just decided?
- 2) Review your updated realistic expectations. Will this list cause you to think differently about your call? Run through the expectations, the good and the troubling ones, and jot down the first few things you'd do if you encountered each. Knowing this in advance can give you a greater sense of control over it, resulting in less anxiety.
- 3) List your professional development ideas and place an asterisk beside the one or two you'd like to start with. What's the next step for those?
- 4) Would you prefer to unpack your mission statement on your own and then involve others, or would you prefer to enlist a small group to unpack it with you? If a group, who will you invite? Either way, go to [The Untapped Potential of Your Mission Statement](#) and begin your exploration.
