### Reflection Questions

1. Pause for a moment and assess your current personal relationship with God. Are you too busy in your leadership role? Do you have time to pray for your ministry? For its staff? Do you have time to be still in God's presence and wait to hear his voice?
2. The thought of a Christian leader being a follower first may be new to some people. Reflect on that truth. What difference does it make for your perspective on yourself as a leader? On how you plan?
3. Think of a time when you knew clearly what God wanted you to do in a particular situation. How did you discern God's direction? Are you as close to and reliant on God as you were then?
4. The idea that God wants you, as a leader, to follow him is very liberating. Think about how increased intimacy with God can mean less burden for you.
5. What tangible steps can you take today to grow closer to God?
