### Reflection Questions

1. Are you driven by getting results? If so, set aside an hour or more this week to be silent in God's presence. Start your quiet time by asking the Lord to speak to you about how he evaluates you and your ministry. Reflect on what you can learn from the prophet Jeremiah's experience by contrasting Jer 1:4-5, 7 with Jer 7:27.
2. Consider the big picture of God's overall plan. Our work in ministry is but a part of the process within that plan. Think about all that your ministry does, and all that your role involves, and write down a summary statement or paragraph highlighting what you have control over and what only God has control over. Is there anything that you have carried as your responsibility that you should hand over to God?
3. Christ's yoke is easy, and his burden is light. We will find rest for our souls when we work his way, in gentleness and humbleness. What about you needs to change for you to lead ever more perfectly like Jesus? Whether things need to change or not, write a prayer telling God about the kind of leadership you want to give and ask him to transform you into that person. Make prayer about your leadership a regular part of your prayer life.
