Reflection Questions

1. Describe several ways that the quality of your personal spiritual life affects the health of the ministry you lead, for better or for worse. Is there any part of your personal life that is incongruent with your public representation of Christ through the ministry?
2. Are you committed to living a personal life that protects the welfare of your ministry?
3. How open are you to evaluation by your board? For the good of the ministry, do you and your board have a transparent relationship with each other? Do they give you good performance feedback?
4. Is the thought that your ministry takes *second* place after your relationship with God something you consider on a regular basis? If not, are you losing your intimacy with God to an obsession with your ministry?
5. Your calling is a holy one of great responsibility. Cultivate a transparent relationship with those you answer to and with your staff so that you can find strength in their agreement that your leadership is authentic and pleasing to the Lord.
