- 2. Where on the spectrum would you place your church–does it tend to be isolationist and withdrawn from society, or tend to be more open and engaged with society?
 - a. What are the benefits and risks of the church being where it is on the spectrum?
 - b. Would you like to see it move along the spectrum? Which way? Why?

 - a. How many of the indicators is your church doing something in already?
 - b. Which ones could you start doing something in?
 - c. Could you be doing more than you currently are in any of the indicators?
