Discussion Questions

1. Take a moment to reflect on who “the Other” is to you personally. Do the same to define who “the Other” might be for your ministry as a whole. Are you ready to love them like Jesus loves?
2. How will using love, prayer, spiritual discernment, and deep engagement as your go-to tools change the way you view “the Other?” Determine what God wants you to achieve in your relationship with them and use those tools to move toward his goal.
3. If your ministry doesn’t already have one, develop an intentional discipleship program that includes formation and mission elements. If not a program, at least be intentional about how you want your leadership to develop your staff as Christians. Use the resources mentioned in the blog post to help in that process.
4. Determine how you will measure the effectiveness of your discipleship program, and ultimately the maturity of the Christians in the program. What indicators will mark their development along the way?
5. Commit to being culturally aware and ready at all times to engage with those in your sphere of influence. As a leader, model faithful representation of Christ to the world.
