Reflection Questions

- 1. In your organization, are people being appropriately (sincerely and often) thanked for contributing to its success?
- 2. As a leader, your expressions of thanks are received as both speaking for yourself and the organization. Find as many ways to express thanks as you can so that thanking people stays fresh, such as verbal/written, public/private, gift/letter, and "love language" gestures.
- 3. Thanking people for their personal traits says you value them for who they are. Consider each of your staff members individually. What traits are particularly influential in forwarding your ministry? Thank them for using their gifts!
- 4. Think of a time when a simple word of appreciation changed the course of your day.
